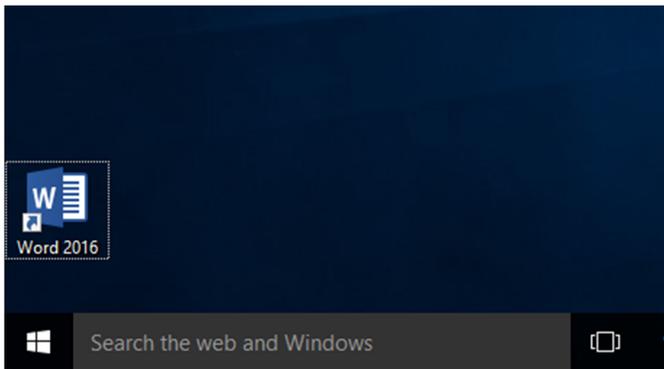


Locating Device Manager in Windows 10

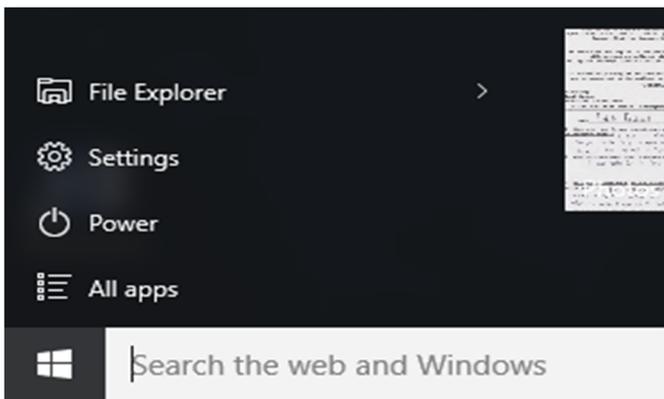
There are, of course, various ways to reach Device Manager in Windows 10. This document will explore three ways to find Device Manager:

1.1 The 'File Explorer' method

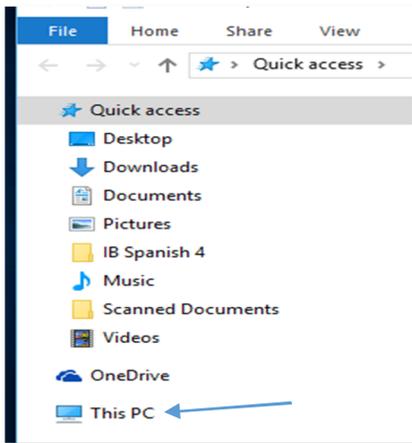
From the Desktop screen, Click on the Windows button  in the lower left hand corner.



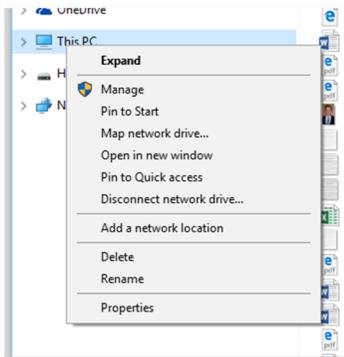
Click on 'File Explorer'.



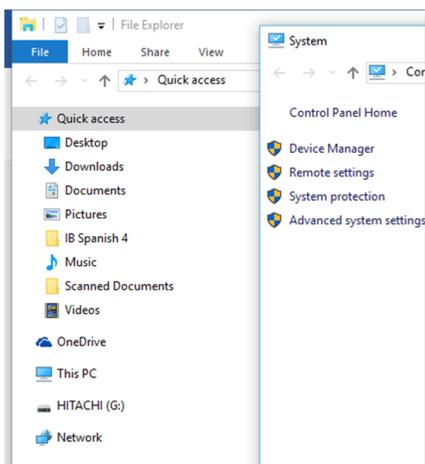
Right Click on 'This PC'.



From the drop down box, click on 'Properties'.

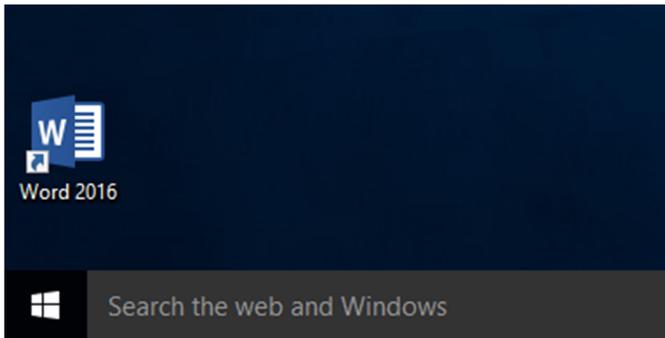


From the Properties/System window, select Device Manager.



1.2 The 'Settings' method

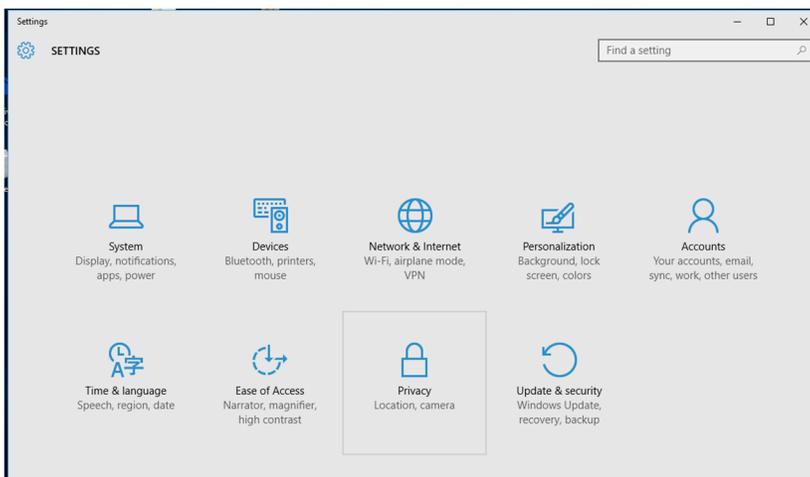
Click on Windows button  in the lower left hand corner.



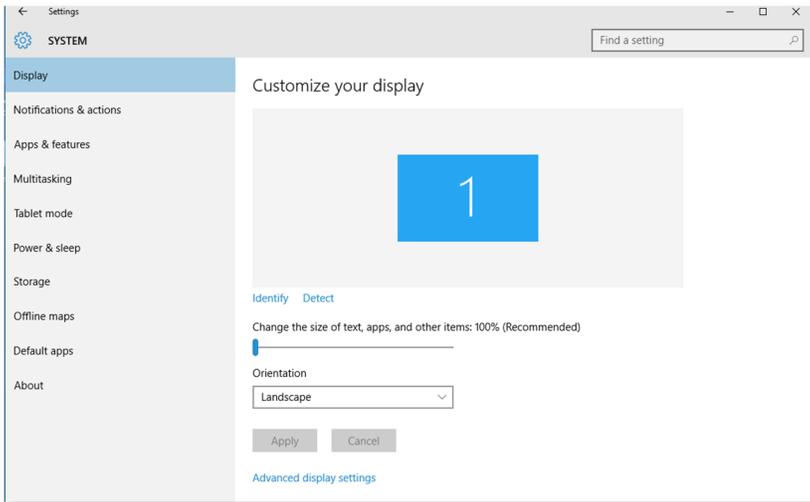
From the Start window, Click on 'Settings'.



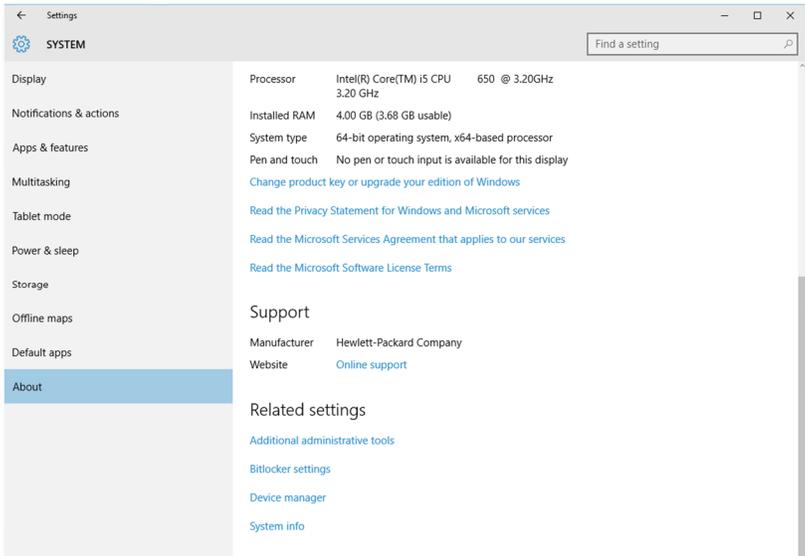
From the 'Settings' window, Click on 'System'



On the Systems window, Click on 'About'.

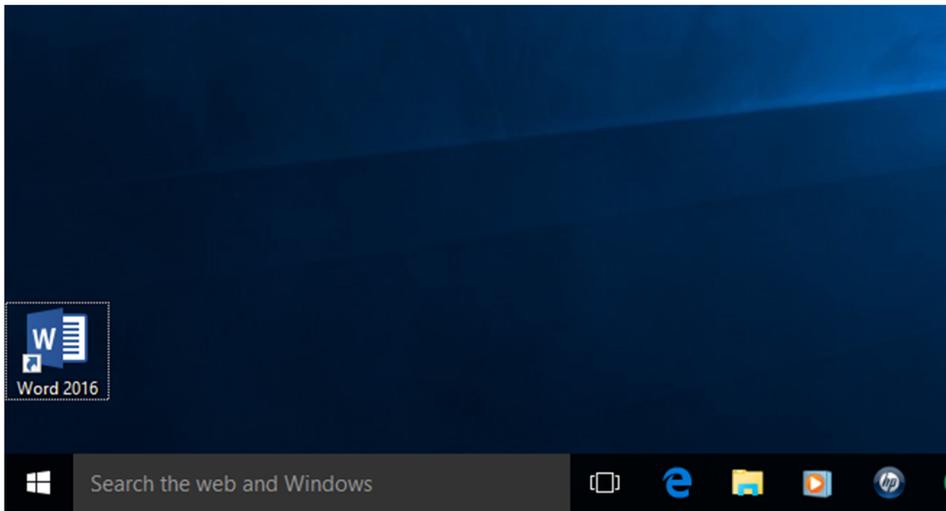


After the 'About' related information appears, scroll down until you see 'Device Manager'.



1.3 The 'Cortana' method

Within the Windows 10 Desktop screen, Cortana may be located within the left side of the Task Bar. (Cortana's placement in this location is a default location, if selected during Windows 10 setup)



Type 'Device Manager' in the Cortana search box. Search results will be displayed.

Click on Device Manager within the search results.
